

Iowa Fire Service Instructors Conference- 2014

At the conclusion of our 2014 conference, someone asked a Iowa Society of Fire Service Instructors board member, "How are we going to top this?" This year's conference did have a special emphasis; it was the Society's 50th anniversary. With the partnership between the Society and the Fire Service Training Bureau, the conference had something for everyone in fire services. Friday afternoon classes included "Crew Resource Management in Training" presented by Jerry Holt, Chief of Urbandle Fire Department, "Training the Next Generation" by Jerry Presta, firefighter from East Norwich (NY); representing for the National Volunteer Fire Council, and "Using the USNG as a Language of Location" by Rob Inouye, Captain of the Cedar Falls Fire Department.

Lacking Personal Preparation


